REPLACEMENT OF NAMEPLATE OR STAMPED DATA FORM

1. APPLICABILITY

This form shall only be used by CSA B51 Certificate of Authorization holders for pressure-retaining items built by a CSA B51 Shop or for ASME code stamped pressure-retaining items requiring a replacement nameplate or re-stamping.

NBIC R Symbol Certificate of Authorization companies shall use form NB-136 as found in Part 2, Section 5 of the *National Board Inspection Code*.

2. AUTHORIZATION

When the stamping on a pressure-retaining item becomes indistinct or the nameplate is lost, illegible, or detached, but traceability to the original pressure-retaining item is still possible, the Inspector shall instruct the owner or user to have the nameplate or stamped data replaced. Re-stamping shall be done in accordance with the original code of construction, except as modified herein. Requests for permission to re-stamp or replace nameplates shall be made to Inspection and Technical Services. Proof of traceability to the original nameplate or stamping and other such data, as is available, shall be furnished with the request.

Permission from Inspection and Technical Services is not required for the reattachment of nameplates that are partially attached. When traceability cannot be established, Inspection and Technical Services shall be contacted.

3. REPLACEMENT OF NAMEPLATE OR STAMPED DATA

The Jurisdictional Inspector shall witness the re-stamping or nameplate replacement installation. Nameplates shall be clearly marked "Replacement" or "Duplicate"

4. RECORD RETENTION

The owner shall retain a copy of this form and associated documentation for the remainder of their ownership of the vessel and shall transfer all documents to the new owner.
